Position Title: NSW Man Cave Facilitator

Position type: Several part-time contracts and casual positions available for work up to 3 days per week.

Location: Based in Sydney (incl. Greater Sydney).

Will require flexibility as well as occasional travel and overnight trips in regional and rural NSW.

Salary: Casual rate \$40.91 per hour (inclusive of casual loading) plus superannuation; Part-time rate \$32.73 plus superannuation.

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POSITION SUMMARY

Man Cave Facilitators are deeply committed and self-aware agents of change who bring extensive knowledge, diverse life experience, unique perspectives and genius to delivering transformational education programs for the young people they serve. The role of a Man Cave Facilitator is to hold and guide safe spaces for young people to deeply connect with themselves and each other, through dynamic workshops which expand emotional intelligence, deconstruct the masculine stereotype and create opportunities to redefine who they want to be. The Man Cave is committed to being a Child Safe organisation and we have zero tolerance for child abuse with emotional and physical wellbeing of our participants being paramount.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Workshop facilitation

- Co-facilitate full day workshops with groups of 25-50 high school young people;
- Participate in, and contribute to, rigorous pre- and post-workshop conversations in teams, to powerfully prepare for and learn from each workshop;
- Safely and diligently manage disclosures and child safety concerns during workshops as they arise;

2. Workshop evaluation, resources and compliance

- Work with the NSW Programs Manager to ensure all required workshop resources are provided;
- Complete the workshop debrief and 'notes for HQ' (headquarters) ensuring that all feedback is provided to the NSW Programs Manager after each program;
- Follow up on any disclosures made in a workshop, including reporting these to necessary stakeholders or authorities based on Man Cave policies and reporting requirements.

3. Development and Training

- Take full responsibility for self-care and personal/mental preparation for workshops, with the support of an incredible Man Cave community; and
- Attend and deeply engage in experiential training provided to expand your facilitation skill-set and deepen your self-awareness.

4. TMC values and cultural behaviours

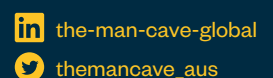
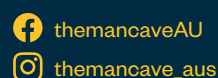
- Subscribe and make best efforts to enact TMC's values and cultural behaviours; and

REQUIREMENTS

- A valid Working With Children Check is a mandatory requirement of this position and will be required prior to commencement.
- It is an inherent requirement of the role that all Facilitators are fully vaccinated against COVID-19 as directed by the NSW Department of Education, unless a specific exception applies and all matters are reasonable in the circumstances. The Man Cave therefore requests that all candidates for our facilitator positions volunteer to provide their vaccination information. We understand the sensitive nature of this information and it will be treated consistently with its sensitivity.
- A key component of Facilitator training is attendance at a weekend retreat. This retreat will take place on **18, 19 and 20 February 2022** and it will be expected that successful candidates attend. Please ensure that you are available for these dates.
